	N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6. Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth. 19.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains WSW.; asc. a gentle SE. slope. 34.70 Trail road, bears ENE. and W. 36.60 Small wash, drains WSW.; asc. a gentle S. slope. 40.92 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with a wooden post, 2 ins. square, 12 ins. long, dimly mkd. and set in a circle of stone. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd: T26N R66E R67E ¼ S 1 S 6 1966 bury original corner post alongside the iron post. N. 0° 31' W., beginning new measurement. 4.50 Trail road, bears SE. and NW.; asc. 40 ft. over a S. slope. 24.10 U. S. Highway No. 50, bears N. 81¼° E. and S. 81¼° W.; asc. 40 ft. over a S. slope. 40.26 The cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 N., Rs. 66 and 67 E., monumented with a squared wooden post and a granite stone, 16x14x10 ins., mkd. with 6 grooves on the N., S., E. and W. faces and set in a mound of stone. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
