9.50	Shallow ravine, drains NE.; asc. 10 ft. over a rolling ESE. slope.
11.67	<p>The closing/^{standard}cor. of Tps. 15 and 16 N., R. 37 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent survey of T. 16 N., R. 37 E.</p> <p>Continue over gently rolling land.</p>
18.80	Low ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 80 ft. over a NW. slope.
29.70	Ravine, drains NE.; asc. 90 ft. over a rolling SE. slope.
