## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 16 North, Range 36 East, M.D.M., Nevada, is situated about 55 miles east of Fallon, Nevada. The elevation varies from 4,800 to 7,300 ft. above sea level.

The south-eastern half of the township is mountainous and the balance is rolling to gently rolling. The soil in this area varies from sandy clay to sandy loam. There are stands of juniper and pinon scattered in the mountainous portion of the township. There were no water sources noted in the survey. There are abandoned gold mining sites in sections 12 and 24.

Access to the township is marginal and is provided through several dead end trail roads. There are numerous large sand bottomed washes that are passable to off-road type vehicles. There are no settlers in the area. Currently, principal users of the township are cattlemen.
