33.00	Spur, slopes SSE.; descend 20 ft. over a SW. slope.
40.08	<p>The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record. This corner now functions for secs. 33 and 34, T. 19 N., R. 36 E., only. I alter the marks on the brass cap to read as follows:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> T19N R36E S 33 S 34 S 4 T18N 1966 1915 </p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, light sandy loam and rocky. Timber, scattered pinon and cedar. Undergrowth, sagebrush.</p>

18.90	<p>From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.</p>
30.40	<p>N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth; ascend a very gradual SE. slope.</p>
40.00	<p>Shallow ravine, drains SE.</p> <p>Small drainage, drains SE.</p> <p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to cap, 3 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> T18N R36E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 35 S 36 1966 </p>
42.70	Shallow ravine, drains SE.
46.00	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains SE.
53.80	Camp Creek, dry, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains SSE.; continue along creek bed.
60.30	Leave Camp Creek, drains S. from NNW.
