

SURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES  
OF T. 16 N., R. 37 E.

CHAINS	
18.30	Trail road, bears ESE. and WNW.
20.70	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains W.; asc. 60 ft. over rolling land, draining WSW.
26.30	Bladed dirt road, bears E. and W. along the crest of a spur, slopes W.; desc. 40 ft. over a N. slope.
31.50	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains W. winding. Asc. 70 ft. over a S. slope.
37.00	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 10 ft. over a N. slope.
40.00	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6.  Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.  T16N R37E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6   S 5  1966  raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.  Desc. 70 ft. over a N. slope.
48.50	Low spur, slopes W.; desc. 20 ft. over N. slope.
50.70	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains W.
52.60	Park Canyon, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains WSW.; asc. 100 ft. over a S. slope.
65.10	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 70 ft. over a N. slope.
75.30	Small wash, drains NW.; desc. 20 ft. over a continued N. slope.
81.55	The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp.  Land, rolling. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush and rabbitbrush.
GENERAL DESCRIPTION	
Township 16 North, Range 37 East, M.D.M., is situated on the western slope of the Desatoya Mountain Range, about 60 miles East of Fallon, Nevada. Access to the area is provided by U. S. Highway No. 50 and supplemented by numerous secondary and trail roads. The elevation varies from 5,300 to 8,000 ft. above sea level. Terrain varies from mountainous to gently rolling.
