42.20	Rock Creek, 4 lks. wide, 3 ins. deep, course NW.; over a broken W. slope.												
46.10	Shallow ravine, drains W.; asc. 600 ft. over a steep, rocky SW. slope.												
66.80	Crest of ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 140 ft. over a NW. slope.												
71.70	Ravine, drains W.; asc. 110 ft. over a SW. slope.												
74.70	Ledge, 30 ft. high, bears E. and W.; asc. 100 ft. over a SW. slope.												
81.01	Intersect the S. bdy. of sec. 35, T. 18 N., R. 37 E. Point for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3.
