GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 30 North, Range 41 East is located in Buffalo Valley. The land in the portion of the township resurveyed is level and the elevation is about 4,600 ft. above sea level. The south boundary crosses an old dry lake bed.

The soil is clay with alkali and the vegetation consists of sparse greasewood and saltgrass. There is no timber.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.

Access into the township is provided by trail roads.
