

TOWNSHIP 9 NORTH, RANGE 43 EAST

<div>CHAINS</div>	<div>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</div> <div>The land within Township 9 North, Range 43 East, ranges from about 5,800 ft. to 7,500 ft. above sea level and is nearly level, except the southeast corner of the township which is rolling to gently rolling. The soil is sandy loam, gravel and rocky. The vegetation consists of shadscale, sagebrush and native grasses. There is some development within the township. All of section 9 is under cultivation and there are several wells scattered throughout sections 9, 16, 20 and 21.</div> <div>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during this survey.</div> <div>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and farmers. Access into the township is provided by State Highway No. 8A, which enters the township in sec. 32 and leaves in sec. 3. Other access within the township is provided by graded, trail and desert roads.</div>
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
