

SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 29 N., R. 42 E.

CHAINS

Land, rolling.
Soil, loam, gravel and rocky.
Undergrowth, sagebrush and shadscale.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 29 N., R. 43 E., is monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record. This cor. now refers to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 29 N., R. 42 E., also, and the brass cap is remarked to read as follows:

21.80 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains ESE.; asc. 120 ft. over a rolling E. slope.

34.60 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains SE.; asc. 70 ft. over an E. slope.

40.03 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
