CHAINS

WEST, bet. secs. 19 and 30.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

0.50 Wash, 40 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains NW.; desc. 10 ft. over a W. slope.

7.00 Trail road, bears ESE. and WNW.

Desc. 30 ft. over a W. slope.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 30.Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

73.22 Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 25, T. 29 N., R. 41 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 30, T. 29 N., R. 42 E., on the E. bdy. of T. 29 N., R. 41 E. and at midpoint on the W. bdy. of sec. 30.Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
