

SURVEY OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 30 N., R. 42 E.

CHAINS

From this corner, the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 N., R. 41 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 30 N., R. 41 E., bears N. $1^{\circ} 43' W.$, 4.42 chs. dist.

From the same corner, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 29 N., R. 41 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 29 N., R. 41 E., bears S. $1^{\circ} 43' E.$, 35.50 chs. dist.

Land, nearly level.
Soil, clay alkali.
Undergrowth, barren.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. $0^{\circ} 06' W.$, bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; desc. 280 ft. over a N. slope, changing to a NW. slope.

39.92 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at midpoint.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
