in 1872.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of
the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set,
mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

N. 0° 03' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

40.03 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at pro-
portionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of
the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
