CHAINS	
84.10	Paved road, bears N. 71½° E. and S. 71½° W.
84.70	Telephone line, parallels paved road; asc. over a gradual S. slope.
89.99	<p>The closing cor. of T. 30 N., Rs. 43 and 44 E., monumented with the remains of a wooden post, loosely set in a mound of stone on a mound of earth. This corner now becomes an amended monument.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a copper-coated steel stake, 24 ins. long, ½ in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap, 1½ ins. diam., mkd.</p> <p>BLM AM  1967</p> <p>bury the remains of the wooden post alongside the steel stake and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of monument.</p>
90.48	<p>Intersect the Sixth Standard Parallel North.</p> <p>Point for the closing cor. of T. 30 N., Rs. 43 and 44 E.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p>T31N R44E S 36 S 1   S 6 R43E R44E T30N CC  1967</p> <p>set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</p> <p>From this corner</p> <p>The standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36, bears N. 89° 34' W., 12.24 chs. dist.</p> <p>Land, nearly level to gently rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam. Undergrowth, shadscale and budsage.</p>
