DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,

30 N., R. 43 E. CHAINS GENERAL DESCRIPTION The land within Township 30 North, Range 43 East, varies from rolling in the northeast and east central portions to nearly level in the south portion to gently rolling in the remaining area. The elevation ranges from about 4,600 to 5,200 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam and rocky on the higher elevations to alkaline clay loam on the lower elevations. The vegetation consists of shadscale, budsage, greasewood, sagebrush and sparse native grasses. The township is drained by Reese River crossing the southeast portion of the township in a northeasterly course and Willow Creek crossing secs. 5, 6 and 7 in a southwesterly course. There are wells located in secs. 8, 9, 24 and 35. portion of the Chiara Ranch is situated in secs. 24 and 25 and a portion of Ruffli's Ranch is located in secs. 35 and 36. There is a telephone facility building in sec. 16. There has been considerable mineral prospects in the northern portion of the township, but no developments. A tailings pond is located in secs. 9 and 10 which is used in connection with milling operations in T. 31 N., R. 43 E. Other users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the area is provided by an improved road to Buffalo Valley bearing west-southwest across the township and supplemented by numerous trail roads.
