MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA


From the cor. of secs. 24, 24, 25 and 25, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 29 N., R. 44 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same Group.

EAST, bet. secs. 24 and 25.

Over mountainous land, through scattered timber.

0.745 Point for the closing cor. of secs. 24 and 25, on the W. bdy. of T. 29 N., R. 45 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



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raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 19 and 30, T. 29 N., R. 45 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the W. bdy. of T. 29 N., R. 45 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same Group, bears S. 0° 46' W., 5.952 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, sandy gravel.
Timber, juniper and pinon.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.

The point for the E. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 25, on the W. bdy. of T. 29 N., R. 45 E., and due EAST of the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 25, Tps. 29 N., Rs. 44 and 44½ E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 29 N., R. 44 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same Group.

CORNER NOT MONUMENTED.

From this point, the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 25, Tps. 29 N., Rs. 44 and 44½ E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 29 N., R. 44 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same Group, bears WEST, 0.03 chs. dist.
