

SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 30 N., R. 44½ E.

CHAINS

The point for the E. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 30 N., R. 44½ E., on the W. bdy. of sec. 31, T. 30 N., R. 45 E., and due EAST of the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 36 and 36.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed within Township 30 North, Range 44½ East is gently rolling desert land. The elevation ranges from about 4,780 to 5,160 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy gravel. The vegetation consists of shadscale, budsage, sagebrush and sparse native grasses. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Access into the area is provided by graveled roads. Principal users of the area are cattlemen.
