Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by
S. T. Morse, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1901.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a basalt stone, 16x10x4 ins., plainly mkd. with 2 grooves on the E. face, 4 grooves on the W. face and loosely set in a mound of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
