From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 7, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.
N. $0^{\circ} 07' W.$, along the W. bdy. of sec. 7.

Over mountainous land, through medium undergrowth; desc.
200 ft. over an E. slope.

- 9.00 Spur, slopes NNE., changing to NE.; desc. 250 ft. over
a N. slope.
- 23.00 Base of mountains, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 20 ft. over
a gradual N. slope.
- 33.11 The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 30 N., R. 45 E.,
hereinafter described.
- Desc. 20 ft. over a gradual N. slope.
- 39.64 The cor. of secs. 6 and 7, monumented with a slate stone,
20x18x14 ins., plainly mkd. with 1 groove on the N. face,
5 grooves on the S. face and firmly set in a mound of
stone.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 16 ins.
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap,
4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
