	<p>From the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, T. 32 N., R. 44 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.</p> <p>WEST, bet. secs. 25 and 36.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p> <p>2.40 Trail road, bears NE. and SW.</p> <p>22.50 Trail road, bears NNE. and SSW.</p> <p>40.00 The iron post set at this point in 1966 to monument the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36 only is removed.</p> <p>43.27 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record. 	<p>WEST, beginning new measurement.</p> <p>32.10 Trail road, bears SE. and NW.</p> <p>35.00 Base of ascent, bears SE. and NW.; asc. 90 ft. over a NE. slope.</p> <p>40.04 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.</p> <p>Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy loam and alkali. Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land where the survey was made lies along the east side of the Battle Mountains adjacent to the Reese River Valley. The elevation ranges from 4,500 ft. to 5,000 ft. above sea level. The land varies from gentle rolling to mountainous.</p> <p>The soil is sandy loam, rocky and some alkali. The vegetation consists of greasewood, shadscale and sagebrush with some native grasses.</p> <p>Access to this area is by trail roads from the town of Battle Mountain which is approximately 3 miles NNE. of sec. 36.</p> <p>Blossom Springs is located in the SE. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 36.</p>
