	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	Township 29 North, Range 45 East, M.D.M., is situated largely on the western slope of the Shoshone Mountains, about 18 miles south of Battle Mountain, Nevada.
	Access to the area resurveyed is provided by several improved and unimproved gravel roads branching from nearby Nevada State Highway Route 8A.
	Water sources in the resurveyed portion consist of Trout and Mill Creeks, flowing northwesterly.
	No mineral formations of significance were noted.
	Vegetation consists of sagebrush undergrowth and scattered juniper and pinon timber.
	There are no residents in the vicinity of this resurvey.
	Principal users of the area are cattlemen.
