40.00	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T17N R33½E ¼ S 36 S 1 T16N R33½E 1966 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor. Desc. 60 ft. over gently rolling land to the closing tp. cor.
