GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 17 North, Range 33½ East, M.D.M., is situated in Fairview Valley about 32 miles ESE. of Fallon, Nevada. Access to the area is provided by U. S. Highway No. 50 and a number of trail roads. The terrain is nearly level with elevations averaging about 4,200 ft. above sea level.

The soil ranges from sandy clay to clay sand. Vegetation is comprised chiefly of sagebrush, shadscale and sand-grass. There is no timber. There is a windmill located in section 13 and is the only water source at present. The township has no residents. The principal value of the township is for grazing.
