	<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>Township 17 North, Range 33½ East, M.D.M., is situated in Fairview Valley about 32 miles ESE. of Fallon, Nevada. Access to the area is provided by U. S. Highway No. 50 and a number of trail roads. The terrain is nearly level with elevations averaging about 4,200 ft. above sea level.</p> <p>The soil ranges from sandy clay to clay sand. Vegetation is comprised chiefly of sagebrush, shadscale and sand-grass. There is no timber. There is a windmill located in section 13 and is the only water source at present. The township has no residents. The principal value of the township is for grazing.</p>
