GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 18 North, Range $33\frac{1}{2}$ East, M.D.M., is located about 30 miles east of Fallon, Nevada on the west side of Dixie Valley and on the eastern slope of the Stillwater Mountains. Access to the area is limited to several trail roads branching from the Dixie Valley Road.

The terrain varies from gently rolling to mountainous, with elevations from 4,250 to 5,000 feet above sea level. The township is drained to the east. The soil ranges from sandy clay to rocky. Vegetation is comprised of brush and sparse grasses; there is no timber.

There are no improvements in the township. Currently, the area's major use is grazing; there are no residents.
