Surveyor, in 1916, Group No. 44.</p> <p>Beginning at the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the E. bdy. of T. 17 N., R. 34 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set; mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.</p> <p>NORTH, bet. secs. 1 and 6.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, draining SW., through medium dense undergrowth; asc. 90 ft. to the point for the <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> sec. cor.</p>
17.00	Wash, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains WSW.
20.60	Wash, 60 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.
33.60	Trail road, bears NE. and SW.
36.60	Wash, 50 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains WSW.
39.14	Point selected for the witness $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6.
	<p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>WC T17N R34E R35E <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> S 1 ↑ S 6 1966</p> </div>
	<p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> ft. high, W. of cor.</p>
40.14	Point for the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This point is located in the center of a wash channel, 130 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, draining WSW. It is not practicable to remonument at true point.
42.10	Wash channel, same drainage, 50 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains WSW.; asc. 200 ft. over a rolling S. slope.
58.00	Spur, slopes ESE.; desc. 40 ft. over a rolling NE. slope.
61.70	Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 130 ft. over a rolling SW. slope.
69.60	Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 60 ft. over a NNE. slope.
