	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>Township 17 North, Range 34 East, M.D.M., is situated in Fairview Valley, about 36 miles ESE. of Fallon, Nevada. Access to the area is provided by U. S. Highway No. 50, Dixie Valley road, and numerous unimproved and trail roads.</p> <p>The terrain varies from nearly level to mountainous and elevations range from 4,100 to 5,200 ft. above sea level. The township is drained principally to the north by a major wash exiting in the area at the north boundary of section 4.</p> <p>The soil varies from sand to rocky alluvium. Vegetation is comprised of brush and grasses; there is no timber.</p> <p>Dixie Valley Reservoir No. 2, lies in sections 5 and 6 and occasionally holds small amounts of seasonal flood water. There is no other water source at present. There are no active mines in the township at present; however, there has been considerable amounts of mining and exploration work. The major ores appear to be silver and gold.</p> <p>The township has no residents. Principal values of the area are mining and grazing.</p>
