SURVEY OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF TOWNSHIP 19 NORTH, RANGE 34 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Beginning at the cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 N., Rs. 34 and 35 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 19 N., R. 35 E. This corner now refers to the cor. of Tps. 19 N., Rs. 34 and 35 E. only. I remark the brass cap as follows:

WEST, along the S. bdy. of sec. 36.

Desc. 70 ft. over a rolling S. slope, through scattered undergrowth.

- 6.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains WNW.; over a gentle NW. slope.
- 7.30 Dim track road, bears NNE. and SW.
- 8.40 Wash, 20 lks. wide, drains SW.; asc. 50 ft. over a SE. slope.
- 12.00 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 50 ft. over a SW. slope.
- 17.62 Intersect line 5-1, M.S. No. 3212, Last Corner lode, from which:

Cor. No. 3, M.S. 3053, Lost Sheperd lode, on line 5-1, M.S. 3212, Last Corner lode, monumented with the decayed remains of the buried base of a pine post, 4 ins. square, bears S. 12° 02' E., 12.47 chs. dist.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
