Over rolling land draining SW., through sparse under-  
growth.

18.70 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SW. from E.; asc.  
100 ft. over a broken slope draining generally SW.

30.50 Spur, forks to WSW. and W.; desc. 90 ft. over a N. slope.

34.10 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains WNW., winding;  
asc. 60 ft. over a SSW. slope.

39.20 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 30 ft. over a steep N. slope.

40.00 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

over a SSW. slope.

52.00 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 70 ft. over a NNE. slope.

54.60 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains WNW.; over a  
rolling W. slope.

58.30 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains WSW.; asc. 120 ft.  
over a rolling SW. slope to top of ridge.

67.38 Intersect line 4-5, M.S. No. 3424, Bumble Bee lode, at a  
point from which:
