	<p>This Independent Resurvey Supersedes the Survey Executed by T. K. Stewart, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1884. A diligent search was made for the original corners and none were found.</p>
	<p>Beginning at the standard cor. of Tp. 16 N., Rs. 35 and 36 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 16 N., R. 36 E., surveyed concurrently under Grp. No. 437.</p>
	<p>WEST, along the S. bdy. of sec. 36.</p>
	<p>Over mountainous terrain, through medium dense undergrowth; asc. 180 ft. along a gently rolling S. slope, gradually changing to an ESE. slope.</p>
26.00	<p>Low ridge, at saddle, bears N. and S.; desc. 40 ft. along a rolling N. slope.</p>
37.20	<p>Ravine, drains N.; asc. 50 ft. over a steep NNE. slope.</p>
40.00	<p>Point for the standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36.</p>
	<p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
