GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 16 North, Range 35 East, M.D.M., is situated about 50 miles east of Fallon, Nevada. The elevation varies from about 4,400 to 6,400 ft. above sea level. The terrain is principally mountainous with fringe areas of rolling and nearly level land. The soil is generally sandy clay with gravel. There is no timber in the township and vegetation consists of sagebrush and rabbitbrush.

There are two water wells in section 3 and also a service station and residence building known as Middlegate. There are inactive mines in sections 19 and 32.

Access into the township is provided by Nevada State Highway No. 23, crossing the area north to south in the eastern portion. There are numerous large sand bottomed washes that are passable to off-road type vehicles and several trail roads. Currently principal users of the area are cattlemen.
