

## TOWNSHIP 33 NORTH, RANGE, 34 EAST

## CHAINS

The southeast corner of the township is Nevada Planning Division of the Nevada Highway Department triangulation station NPD WIRE, latitude  $40^{\circ} 40' 28.825''$  N. and longitude  $118^{\circ} 05' 02.084''$  W.

The magnetic declination was read at a number of stations throughout the township and the mean of these readings was found to be  $18^{\circ}$  east.

E. H. Dyer, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1863 and 1864.

The cor. of Tps. 32 and 33 N., Rs. 34 and 35 E. (now the cor. of Tps. 32 and 33 N., Rs. 34 and  $34\frac{1}{2}$  E.), when recovered in the course of the preliminary investigation in 1966, was found to be monumented with a scribed wooden post, 16 ins. long, wired to an iron pipe, 1 in. diam., firmly set.

Ties were made from this corner to three temporary reference points prior to construction of Interstate Highway 80. From these reference points, the corner was recovered on the N. edge of Interstate 80.

At the corner point

Set a copper-coated steel stake, 30 ins. long,  $\frac{1}{2}$  in. diam., 18 ins. below the surface of the road, with brass cap mkd.

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth.

- 0.50 Fence, bears N.  $69-3/4^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $69-3/4^{\circ}$  W.
- 1.00 Oiled frontage road, bears N.  $69-3/4^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $69-3/4^{\circ}$  W.
- 2.15 Telephone line, bears N.  $69-3/4^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $69-3/4^{\circ}$  W.
- 2.18 Point selected for the witness point.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
