Land, nearly level.  
Soil, sandy loam.  
Undergrowth, shadscale and sagebrush.

N. 0° 20' W., bet. secs. 1 and 1.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

40.00 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6 (now the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 1), at record distance, from the cor. of secs. 1, 1, 12 and 12; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

(now the cor. of secs. 1 and 1, Tps. 33 N., Rs. 34 and 34 $\frac{1}{2}$  E.), at record distance from the cor. of secs. 1, 1, 12 and 12, and from the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 33 N., R. 34 E.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
