a mound of stone and plainly mkd. with 6 notches on the  
N., E. and S. edges.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins.  
in the ground to underlying rock and in a collar of stone  
to cap, with brass cap mkd.
