Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
F. H. Criss, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1901.

The 1901 cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 33 N., R. 33 E.,
monumented with a basalt stone, 6x12x16 ins., firmly set
in a mound of stone and plainly mkd. with 5 grooves on
the S. face and 1 groove on the N. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins.
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap,
3½ ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins.
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft.
base, with brass cap mkd.
