3.41 The closing cor. of secs. 6 and 42, T. 33 N., R. 34 E., hereinafter described.

Asc. 10 ft. over a SE. slope.

4.90 Spur, bears E.; desc. 40 ft. over a N. slope.

7.30 Ravine, drains E.; asc. 160 ft. over a S. slope.

15.30 Spur, bears SW.; desc. 50 ft. along a W. slope.

22.70 Bottom of descent in saddle; asc. 110 ft. along an E. slope.

40.60 Spur, bears E.

41.23 The cor. of secs. 1 and 36, Tps. 33 and 34 N., R. 33 E., monumented with a basalt stone, 8x10x14 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone and plainly mkd. with 6 notches on the N., S. and W. edges, T33N on the S. face and R33E on the W. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4½ ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
