Secs. 3, 4, 5 and 6 are dependently resurveyed. To avoid duplication of areas returned as surveyed on the plat of the 1863-1864 Dyer surveys, sec. 4 is now sec. 40, sec. 6 is now sec. 42, the S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. 3 is now sec. 39 and the S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. 5 is now sec. 41.

These field notes also include the survey of subdivision of section lines of secs. 3 and 5 segregating the patented portion of these sections from secs. 39 and 41.

The E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 3 is monumented with a granite stone,  $4\times8\times20$  ins., firmly set in a mound of stone and plainly mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the W. face. This cor. is now the cor. of secs. 3 and 39, on the W. bdy. of sec. 38.
