

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 33 N., R. 34 E.

CHAINS

32.70 Ravine, drains SE.

38.40 Trail road, bears NNE. and SSW.

40.37 The cor. of secs. 5 and 6, now secs. 41 and 42, monumented with a granite stone, 4x8x16 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone and plainly mkd. with 5 notches on the E. and S. faces.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to underlying rock and in a collar of stone to cap, with brass cap mkd.

bury the marked stone alongside the iron post and set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, 2½ ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam and gravelly.

Undergrowth, shadscale, budsage and sagebrush.

N. 89° 54' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 42.

Over rolling land, through medium undergrowth; asc. 70 ft. over a SE. slope.

6.70 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 30 ft. along a S. slope.

12.10 Ravine, drains SSE.; asc. 90 ft. over an E. slope.

18.71 The closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, now secs. 6 and 42, monumented with a granite stone, 4x12x14 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone and plainly mkd. with 5 notches on the S. face, 1 notch on the N. face and CC on the E. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 3½ ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
