DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE E. BDY. OF  
T. 32 N., R. 34 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by E. H. Dyer,  
U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1863.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the  
E. bdy. of the Tp., now the cor. of secs. 1, 1, 12  
and 12, monumented with a wooden post, 2x2x30 ins.,  
plainly scribed and firmly set in a mound of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

reset the original wooden post, set a steel fence post,  
5 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. in the ground, alongside the iron  
post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft.  
high, W. of cor.

N. 1° 04' E., bet. secs. 1 and 1.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

1.00 Trail road, bears E. and W.

8.00 Trail road, bears ESE. and WNW.

40.10 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, now the  $\frac{1}{4}$   
sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 1, at proportionate distance;  
there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
