

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF PORTIONS OF THE EAST AND NORTH
BOUNDARIES OF SEC. 13, T. 32 N., R. 34 E.

CHAINS

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears S. 79° 51½' W., 57.14 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous to gently rolling.
Soil, sandy loam and rocky.
Undergrowth, shadscale, budsage and sagebrush.

SURVEY OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY OF T. 32 N., R. 34½ E.

From the cor. of Tps. 32 and 33, Rs. 34 and 34½ E.

EAST, bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

1.70 Interstate highway No. 80, W. bound lane, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.

7.60 Interstate highway No. 80, E. bound lane, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.

19.83 Intersect the W. bdy. of sec. 5, T. 32 N., R. 35 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 36, Tps. 32 and 33 N., R. 34½ E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From this same corner, the cor. of secs. 5 and 8, T. 32 N., R. 35 E., bears S. 0° 54' W., 34.76 chs. dist., heretofore described.

Land, nearly level.
Soil, sandy loam.
Undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood and sagebrush.
