Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by  
William Epler, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1867.

The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, monumented with a squared wooden post, 3x3x30 ins., dimly scribed and loosely set in a small mound of earth.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground; with brass cap mkd.

reset the wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2 ft. high; W. of cor.

N.  $0^{\circ} 03'$  E., bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Over gently rolling land, through scant undergrowth; asc. a gradual SW. slope.

16.70 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.

29.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.

40.25 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30, monumented with an unmarked wooden post, 2x3x28 ins., loosely set in a small mound of earth.
