N. 0° 39' W., along the W. bdy. of sec. 8.

Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.

33.58 The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 33 N., R. 34½ E.,
monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd.
and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 33 N.,
R. 34½ E., executed concurrently under this same Group.

40.20 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 8, at midpoint on
the W. bdy. of sec. 8.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
