## CHAINS

46.06

The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 34 N., R. 35 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.

Land, nearly level.  
Soil, sandy loam.  
Undergrowth, shadscale and greasewood.

The point for the S. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 6 is at 40.00 chs. westerly in longitude from the SE. cor. of sec. 6 and on the N. bdy. of sec. 1, T. 33 N., R. 34 E.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

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set a steel fence post, 5 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.

From this corner

The NE. cor. of sec. 1, T. 33 N., R. 34 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 33 N., R. 34 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears EAST, 18.66 chs. dist.

The N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 33 N., R. 34 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 33 N., R. 34 E., executed concurrently under this same group, bears WEST, 21.34 chs. dist.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 33 North, Range 35 East, varies from rolling in the eastern portion to nearly level in the northwestern portion to gently rolling in the remaining area except along the Humboldt River which is nearly level bottom land. The elevation ranges from about 4,200 to 4,800 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy in the central portion to sandy loam in the remaining area except along the river bottom which is black loam, affording good grazing land for livestock. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, budsage, greasewood and sparse native grasses with scattered willows along the river. The township is drained by the Humboldt River which crosses the central and southwestern portion in a southwesterly course.
