N. 0° 12' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth; asc. 20 ft. over a gradual SE. slope.</p> <p>15.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains ESE.; asc. 30 ft. over a gradual SE. slope.</p> <p>28.40 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 10 ft. over a gradual N. slope.</p> <p>36.70 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains E.</p> <p>40.21 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with a stone, 16x10x5 ins., firmly set in a small mound of stone and plainly mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T34N R34E R35E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 S 31</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1966</p> <p>bury the original corner stone and set a steel fence post, 5 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</p> <p>From this corner, the NW. cor. of a pump house, bears N. $79\frac{1}{2}$° E., 27.50 chs. dist.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 0° 12' W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Desc. a very gradual N. slope.</p> <p>4.00 Trail road, bears E. and W.</p> <p>4.60 Abandoned water pipeline, bears E. and W.; asc. a very gradual SE. slope.</p> <p>38.40 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SE.</p> <p>40.23 The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, monumented with a stone, 20x6x6 ins., firmly set in a small mound of earth and plainly mkd. 5 notches on the N. edge and 1 notch on the S. edge.</p>
