The cor. of Tps. 3 and 4 S., Rs. 70 and 71 E., monumented
with a basalt stone, 14x12x7 ins., mkd. 6 grooves on the
N., S., E. and W. faces and firmly set in a mound of
stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in
the ground, with brass cap mkd.
