Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with a wooden post, 14 ins. long, 1 in. diam., dimly scribed and set at the cor. of fences which bear S. and E.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
