

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 30 N., R. 60 E.

CHAINS	
	Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush and crested wheatgrass.
40.17	N. 0° 44' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3. Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth. Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T30N R60E S 3 ¼ S 2 1967 raise a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. 55.00 Unimproved road, bears SE. and NW. 78.28 Intersect the Sixth Standard Parallel North. Point for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T31N S 34 S 3 ¼ S 2 T30N R60E CC 1967 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, S. of cor. From this corner, the standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, bears S. 89° 41' E., 19.24 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the resurvey of the Sixth Standard Parallel North, through R. 60 E., executed concurrently, under this same group. Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush and crested wheatgrass.
