Deputy Surveyors, in 1870.</p> <hr/> <p>From the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.</p> <p>N. 0° 08' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p> <p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a deteriorated wooden post, dimly scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ and loosely set in a mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T31N R60E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 35 S 36</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1967</p> <p>bury the wooden post and set a steel fence post alongside the iron post.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 0° 27' E., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over nearly level land.</p>
