

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY, T. 30 N., R. 61 E.

## CHAINS

raise a mound of stone,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, gently rolling.  
Soil, sandy clay.  
Undergrowth, sagebrush.

N.  $0^{\circ} 13'$  W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth.

16.60 Trail road, bears SW. and NE.

21.00 Trail road, bears NW. and SE.

27.00 Small wash, drains SE.

29.20 Same wash, drains SW.

39.78 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

The closing cor. of T. 30 N., Rs. 61 and 62 E., monumented with a limestone,  $18 \times 14 \times 8$  ins., set in a mound of stone and mkd. with 6 notches on the E., W. and S. edges.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
