

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF MINERAL SURVEY NO. 3458

## CHAINS

- 2.70 Ravine, drains SE.
- 10.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains S.
- 13.85 Cor. No. 4, M.S. 3458, THE DOCTOR MINE, monumented with a small mound of stone buried in the sod.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground and in a collar of stone with brass cap mkd.

- Point for the center  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 16, at the intersection with the E. and W. center line of sec. 16 and identical with A.P. No. 3 of Tract 37, hereinafter described.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 3 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
