DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE FRACTIONAL WEST BOUNDARY OF
T. 16 N., R. 28 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by Reilly and
Magee, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881.

The cor. of Tps. 16 and 17 N., Rs. 27 and 28 E.,
monumented with a lava stone, 15x10x8 ins., plainly
mkd. with 6 grooves on each of four faces and firmly
set. The mkd. stone is exposed 4 ins. above the ground
and a steel fence post is firmly set alongside. The
corner is situated in a fence bearing E. and W.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post
and reset the steel fence post. Raise a mound of stone
3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

S. $0^{\circ} 19'$ E., along the W. bdy. of sec. 6.

Over gently rolling land, through medium dense under-
growth.

14.60 Low bench bears E. and W.; desc. 40 ft. over a rolling
S. slope.

29.00 Shallow draw, drains ESE.; over nearly level land.

40.26 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at pro-
portionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of
the original corner. This corner now refers to sec. 6
only.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground; with brass cap mkd.
